Root Chakra- note C - base of the spine...Characteristics of a balanced root chakra are strong and determined feelings that life is good. There is a belief that dreams will easily manifest and there is worthiness of abundance and security; there is prosperity in all areas of life. There is a connective ness to the physical which builds the foundation for all higher charkas as the root chakra is the source of life-force.

Sacral Chakra – note C# - transitional point between the sacrum and lumbar spine...C# supports the sacral chakra. This vibration bridges the characteristics and attributes of the first chakra, note “C” which is related to foundation and family and the second chakra, note “D” which relates to movement and a relationship with one another. This bridge moves us out of the family tribe and into a dance with a partner in life.

Sacral Chakra – note D - in hip region...The characteristics of a strong sacral charka are the connectedness to self, other humans, animals, nature and the spiritual world. A balanced sacral chakra connects us to our pure creative energies that truly nourish our being; it houses our creative juices. There is a sense of “awe” with every sight, sound and experience as if life were new and original. The essence of the sacral chakra is to allow the soul to embrace the body.

Solar Plexus Chakra- Note Eb – transitional point between the lumbar and the thoracic spine...Eb supports the solar plexus chakra. This vibration bridges the characteristics and attributes of the second chakra note “D” which is related to relationship and partnership and the third chakra note “E” which is related to individual and self. This semitone bridges our connection with others into how we feel about our self-esteem, our self worth and ourselves. In order to have a strong relationship with others, we have to have a strong relationship with ourselves first. It is important to grasp the concept that we fit into this world as perfectly as a blade of grass

Solar Plexus Chakra – note E - located in gut...Characteristics of a strong solar plexus chakra are a healthy sense of personal identity and a strong sense of personal power. A balanced sacral chakra is all about “me”. It is about our self-esteem, our ego, personal power, will, and responsibility and gut intuition. We need to know who we are, own our personal power and take responsibility for our own lives. Third chakra energy is logical instead of artistic, sophisticated instead of innocent, suspicious instead of trusting and responsibility bound instead of free flowing. The second chakra follows the right brain identity whereas the third chakra thinks like the left-brain.

Heart Chakra – Note F - located in the chest...The characteristics of a balanced heart chakra is acting out of love and compassion and recognizing that the most powerful energy we have is love. The heart chakra is all about unity, peace, and unconditional love; hope, forgiveness, compassion and generosity. As the heart chakra opens so does the ability to connect with the higher self. It radiates love and forgiveness.

Heart Chakra – Note F# - transitional point between the thoracic and the cervical spine...F# supports the heart chakra. This vibration bridges the characteristics and attributes of the fourth chakra “note F”, which is related to compassion and unconditional love and the fifth chakra “note G” which is related to the freedom of expression. This semitone takes information from the heart and moves it into the throat for expression. This vibration supports us in finding our calling in life and establishing our self in the world. This vibration helps us go after what we want and to have a positive attitude about our accomplishments.

Throat Chakra - Note G - located at the throat...The characteristics of a balanced throat chakra are the ability to communicate openly with personal expression. The throat chakra is the expression of the spoken word for all of the chakras. Through the fifth chakra we express everything that is alive within us such as our laughing, crying, our feelings of love and happiness, anxiety and aggressiveness, our intention and desires as well as our ideas knowledge and perception of the inner worlds.

Throat Chakra - Note G# - transitional point between the cervical spine and the skull...G# supports the throat chakra. This vibration bridges the characteristics and attributes of the throat chakra “note G” which relates to the freedom of expression and the brow chakra “ note A” which relates to inner direction. This vibration gives us the ability to express ourselves in accordance to our life’s journey. It supports us in our personal growth by helping us to awaken to our spiritual consciousness.

Brow Chakra – Note A - location is at the forehead...The characteristic of a balanced brow chakra is the use of mental power, connecting with the process of manifestation. The brow chakra enables us to connect with the energy of the world beyond our five senses and teaches us to go beyond the superficial appearances and find our deeper truths and then cultivate our resources of creativity and wisdom. Through the sixth chakra we are able to open ourselves to universal creative energy, which allows us to direct ourselves towards fulfilling our life’s purpose.

Brow Chakra – note Bb - transitional point where the top of the head meets the etheric...Bb supports the brow chakra. This vibration bridges the characteristics and attributes of the brow chakra “ note A” which relates to inner direction and “note B” which relates to spiritual connection. The importance of this semitone is to prepare us for the next transition and that is into the spiritual realm, which signifies the completion of the cycle of life. Bb is the transition between the attachment to the physical identity and to the identification of the self as a divine spark. This transition point cannot be activated until the other vibrational frequencies are aligned. If you use the vibrational essence of Bb without having put the other pieces together, there will be no effect.

Crown Chakra – Note B - location- top of the head...Characteristics of a balanced crown chakra, is being connected wholly with the universe, self and God. Life is flowing freely and there is a deep sense of peace. Through the seventh chakra, we get our divine inspiration and our divine creativity. This is the chakra where everything comes together and we get the big picture. This is where all the information from all the charkas merges. When this chakra is balanced, there is a sense of peace, serenity, knowing and a connection with the universe.
